Again and again I have been shown that the past experiences of God's people are not to be counted as dead facts. We are not to treat the record of these experiences as we would treat a last year's almanac. The record is to be kept in mind, for history will repeat itself. Publishing Ministry, p. 175

"The work of God in the earth presents, from age to age, a striking similarity in every great reformation or religious movement. The principles of God's dealing with men are ever the same. The important movements of the present have their parallel in those of the past, and the experience of the church in former ages has lessons of great value for our own time." The Great Controversy, p. 343 (emphasis supplied)

The Great Reformatory Movements of the past (Noah, Moses, Elijah, Cyrus, John the Baptist) parallel the Great Reformation of our day, William Miller and Seventh-day Adventism.

There are seven "Waymarks" clearly evident and always in the same order in every great reform movement in Bible history, each with its own "Characteristics", but you will notice that the Characteristics within a Waymark are not always in the same order, and that not all of the Characteristics appear in every "Waymark", but the "striking similarity" is clearly evident in every Great Reformatory Movement.

In order to clarify the overlapping aspects of the Great Reformatory Movements list given before as it applies to the <u>Millerites</u> and the <u>144,000</u>; apply the truth that in this 3 + 1 sequence (meaning the 3 Angels plus the 4th Angel), the <u>4th</u> Angel's message is a <u>repeat</u> of the <u>2nd</u> Angel's message that "<u>Babylon is fallen</u>".

"Great power and glory were imparted to the angel, and as he descended, the earth was lightened with his glory. The light which attended this angel penetrated everywhere, as he cried mightily, with a strong voice, "Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird." <u>Rev. 18:2</u>. The message of the <u>fall of Babylon</u>, as given by the <u>second angel</u>, <u>is repeated</u>, with the additional mention of the corruptions which have been entering the churches since 1844." <u>The Faith I Live By</u>, p.335 (emphasis supplied.)

Other linking statements:

The Loud Cry of the 4th Angel joins the 3rd Angel as the Midnight Cry joined the 2nd Angel (EW 277-278)

Both are empowered by the Holy Spirit (Spirit of Prophecy, vol. 4, p.429) Both illustrate the parable of the Ten Virgins (R&H Aug. 19, 1890) Both are cleansing messages (2SM 118) Both are testing messages (9T 228)

<u>Repetition</u> of the <u>Millerite time</u> during the development of the <u>144,000</u> is evident <u>in Scripture</u>.

<u>Rev. 10:1-3</u> applies to <u>both</u> times because <u>two</u> passages of <u>Daniel</u> (8:14 & 11:40-45), were opened or <u>unsealed</u> at <u>separate times</u> (roughly in the 1830's and the 1990's). <u>Rev. 10:4-6</u> applies to the <u>Millerite</u> time.

National Sunday Law marks the complete fall of Babylon. (Other Thunders follow "in their order")

3rd Thunder:

Disappointment: The National Sunday Laws progressing around the world will be a shock to God's people.

4th Thunder:

Corresponding "slump in activity" or a "Tarrying Time."

5th Thunder:

After recovering their wits (and receiving the spiritual power of the <u>Latter Rain</u> in reply to their earnest prayers), God's people begin to proclaim the fall of Babylon to the world, as the Millerites did.

6th Thunder:

The proclamation swells into the global Loud Cry, the final call to "Come out of her My people!"

7th Thunder: Jesus comes!
